## News...

When we didn't think this year could get any stranger - we have just had this last week. The children have taken this all in their stride and we are so proud of the way they have handled the very sudden school closure and remote learning in general. They have had to get covid tests, some have been poorly and they have had to deal with lots of uncertainty in many homes; we can't praise them enough. We know how resilient children are but they have certainly had a difficult 16 months. We are praying September will bring with it 'normal' school life. We would also like to thank you - our parents, who have been so supportive to us as a senior leadership team and all the staff. The teachers hate being at home and we have all been deeply upset by the past week but your messages of support have kept us going. Thank you! Thank you again to the 50 parents for taking your children and yourselves to gain a PCR test - this really is the best way to stop the spread. However, this low number (less than half) puts all of our community at risk if children return to school without having had a PCR test as advised by the local outbreak team. It is very worrying that bubble closures and potential a further school closure could happen all over again.
Please, I urge everyone who has not yet had a PCR test (children and family members) to get a test and complete the form using the link below.
We are still having positive cases come through from children who were in contact last week showing that it can take over a week. Please do not feel that if you child doesn't have it now, they are clear. So many children are asymptomatic too. I know many are testing daily with LFD tests, but these are not as reliable as getting a PCR test.

Mrs Archer will continue to teach across the school as will Mr Massam who will teach the children PE. We are not going to be able to allow the children to spend time with their new teacher this side of the holidays but hopefully they had a good chat on this mornings zoom call. We will plan in a 'Meet the Teacher' meeting for yourselves in September for you to meet them. (Hopefully in person)
Summer holiday provision - if you are entitled to free school meals because of your household income, then you will have received a letter this week to sign up and register for this over the holidays. The initial interest deadline is Monday $5^{\text {th }}$ and the deadline for signing children up is Friday $9^{\text {th }}$. Children in Ladybirds and Key Stage 1 who have universal free school meals funded by the government are not eligible.

If children have finished their isolation period, we will see them back in school on Tuesday as Monday $5^{\text {th }}$ is an INSET day. (No remote learning) If not, there will be daily remote learning on Showbie as normal. The staff will be teaching but they will provide the children chance to connect in to the classrooms where possible. Have a good weekend and thank you again for your continued support. Mrs Jones
